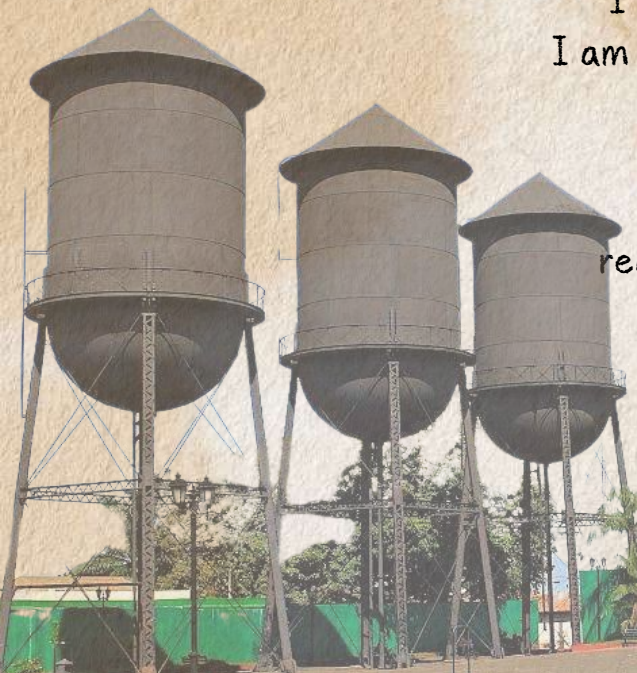


I am from drinking coffee every day at six am,

we can change this reality.





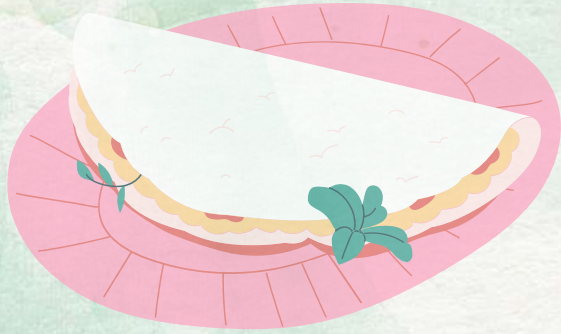

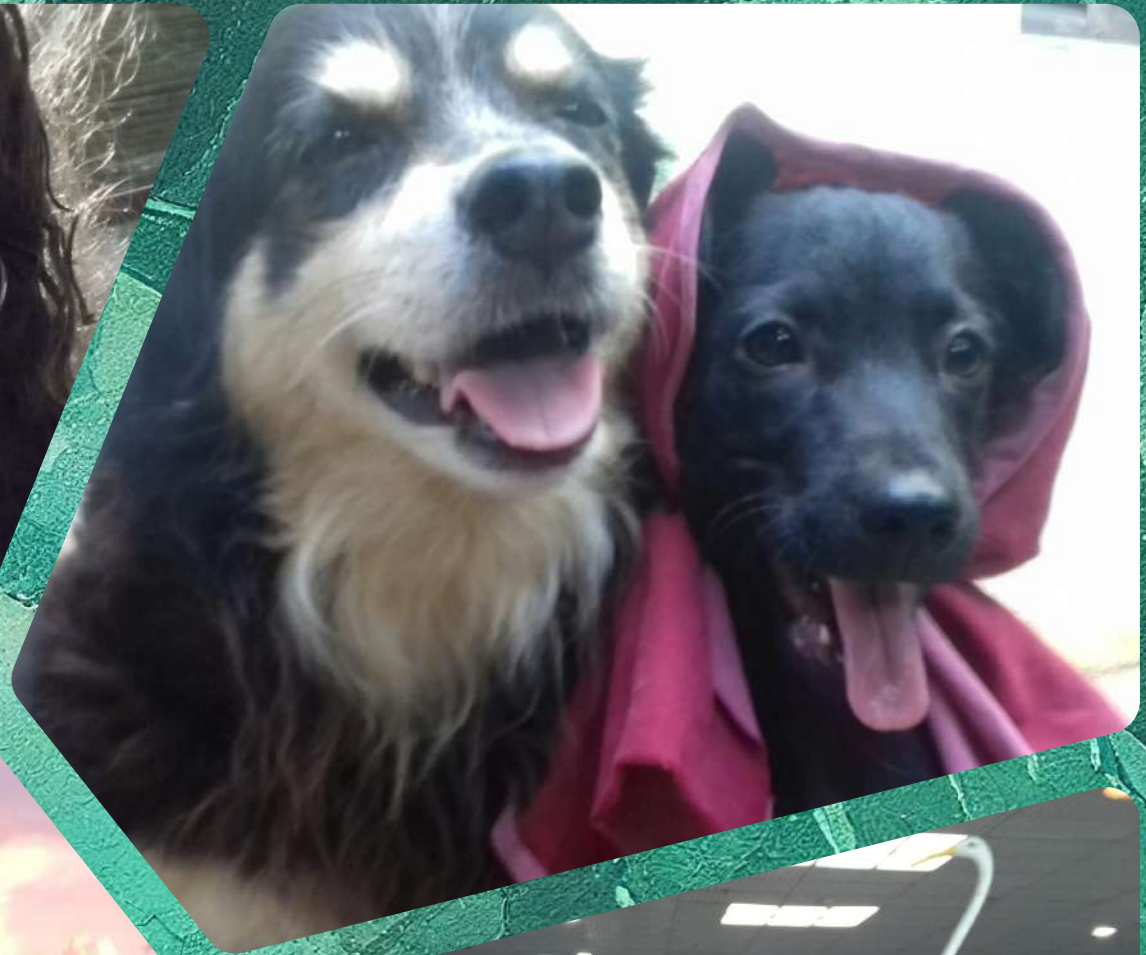
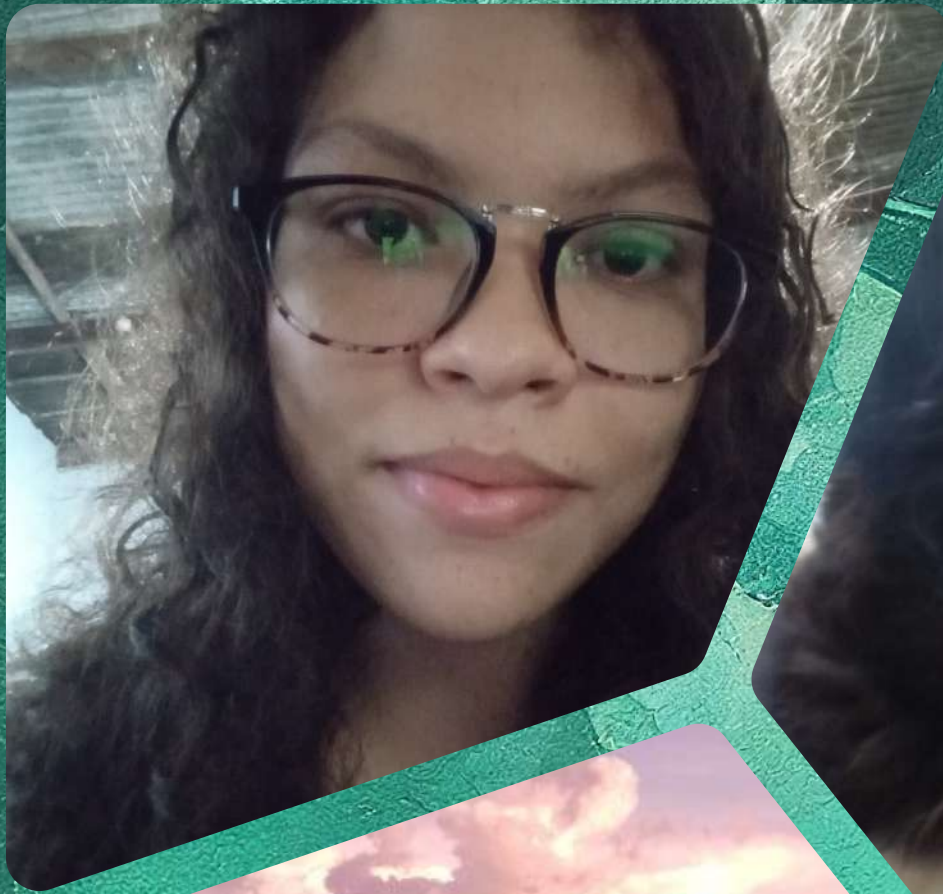
I am from being a fan of "tapioca" and "acerola" juice.

and many more Brazilian food that I love.

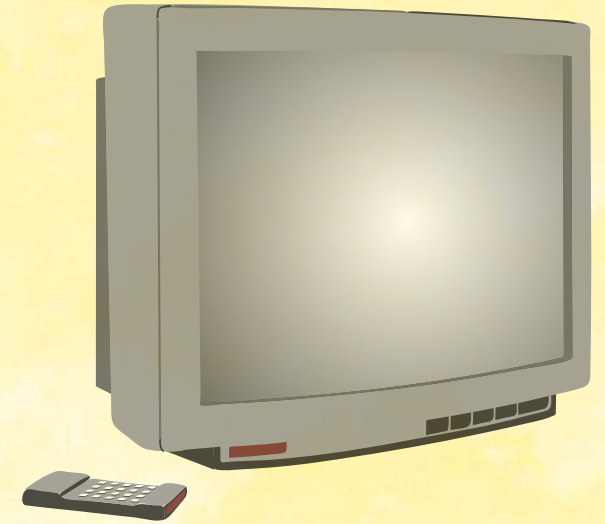




Milka Patricia

I am from "Alegria", "Rolim de Moura" and Cacoal.

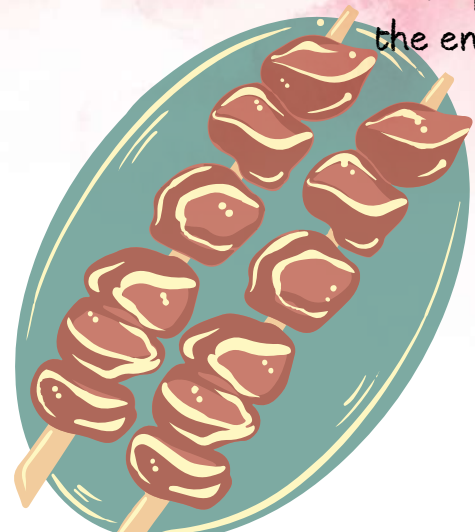
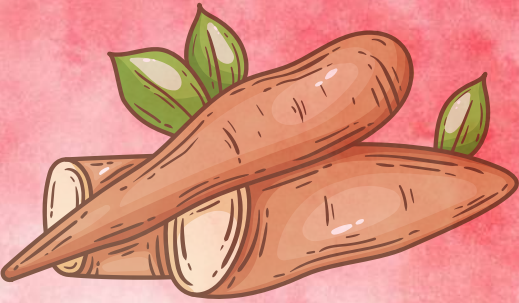
I am from eating lots of barbecue because my family loves it

I am from the long Faroeste Caboclo song

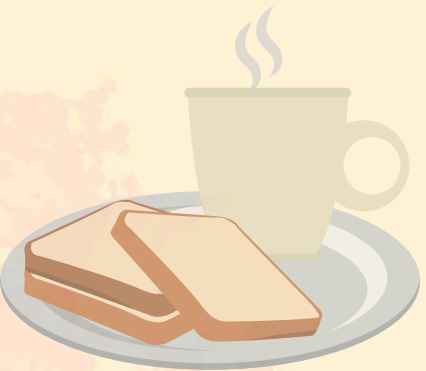
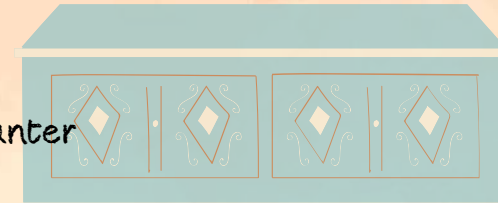
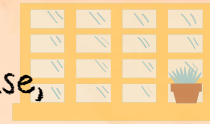
I am from the old Porto Velho and that small city in Maranhão

I am from listening to some instruments that I've never learned how to play.

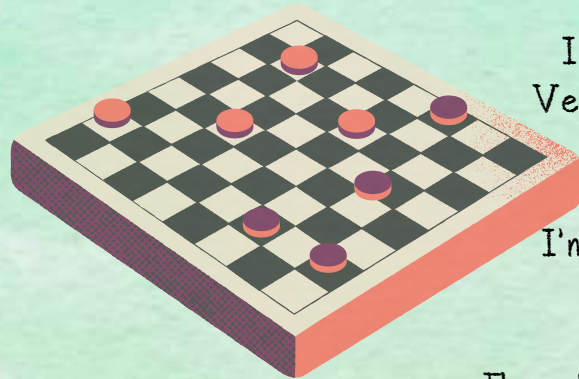
Sorry, I'm a flutist

I'm from Ferreira's and Monteiro's

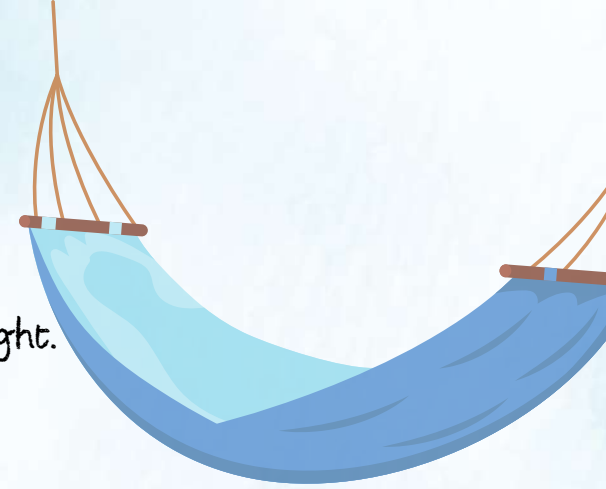
I am from eating all the meals with my family and talking loudly
